Subject: Dress Parade

To All Company Commanders:

You will all read and be responsible for knowing the content of the attached correspondence and orders from Army and Brigade Headquarters.

Please take note of the dress regulations for the Parade.

Regulation headwear for the National Regiment for the Dress Parade will be as follows:

Enlisted men: forage caps ONLY. For ALL Officers: regulation forage caps or kepis. NO slouch or other hats will be permitted to be worn for the Dress Parade, Pass in Review ceremony.

In addition, ALL personnel to try and acquire white gloves for the Parade. Officers may wear white gloves or gauntlets. Sashes will be worn by all Officers.

Captain App will assign color bearer and color guard from within his company.

He will also pay special attention to the location of the color guard for the Ceremony.

The last exercise of the Regimental battalion drill Saturday morning will be an evening-out of the companies. We will try to get the companies to be within one or two files of each other.

Lt. Col. Hanson and Major Adler, with the assistance of Adjutant Podszus and Sgt. Major Cronin will attend to their respective wings. This will be for the Dress Parade ONLY.

I feel confident that the officers and men of the National Regiment will do everything in their power to make the NR the premier unit on the field.

Pass this information on to your subordinate officers and NCO's so all may be versed on what is to be expected of them.
