**\*Very Important Reenactor Information\***

**PASS & PHOTO I.D. REQUIRED:** You must have valid Photo ID to register. After registering each reenactor is required to present their pass and photo I.D. upon entering the Reenactor parking and camps. **You must have your pass at all times. Each person in a vehicle must have a pass and photo I.D. or you will not be allowed entry.** If you do not have your pass, or have forgotten or misplaced your pass, it will be necessary to return to registration for a replacement. CSA reenactors will also be required to show their pass when re-entering the CSA camp on foot from the CSA parking area. Please be considerate and respectful of gate personnel. They have a very difficult job so your cooperation, a smile and thank you is always appreciated!

**CARS IN CAMP:** One persistent and legitimate reenactor complaint is that the cars in the camps during the event significantly detract from everyone's experience. The solution is to simply be considerate, get unloaded and remove your vehicle immediately after unloading – even if it is open vehicle hours. The camps closed to vehicle regulations will be strictly enforced by organizers and military command.

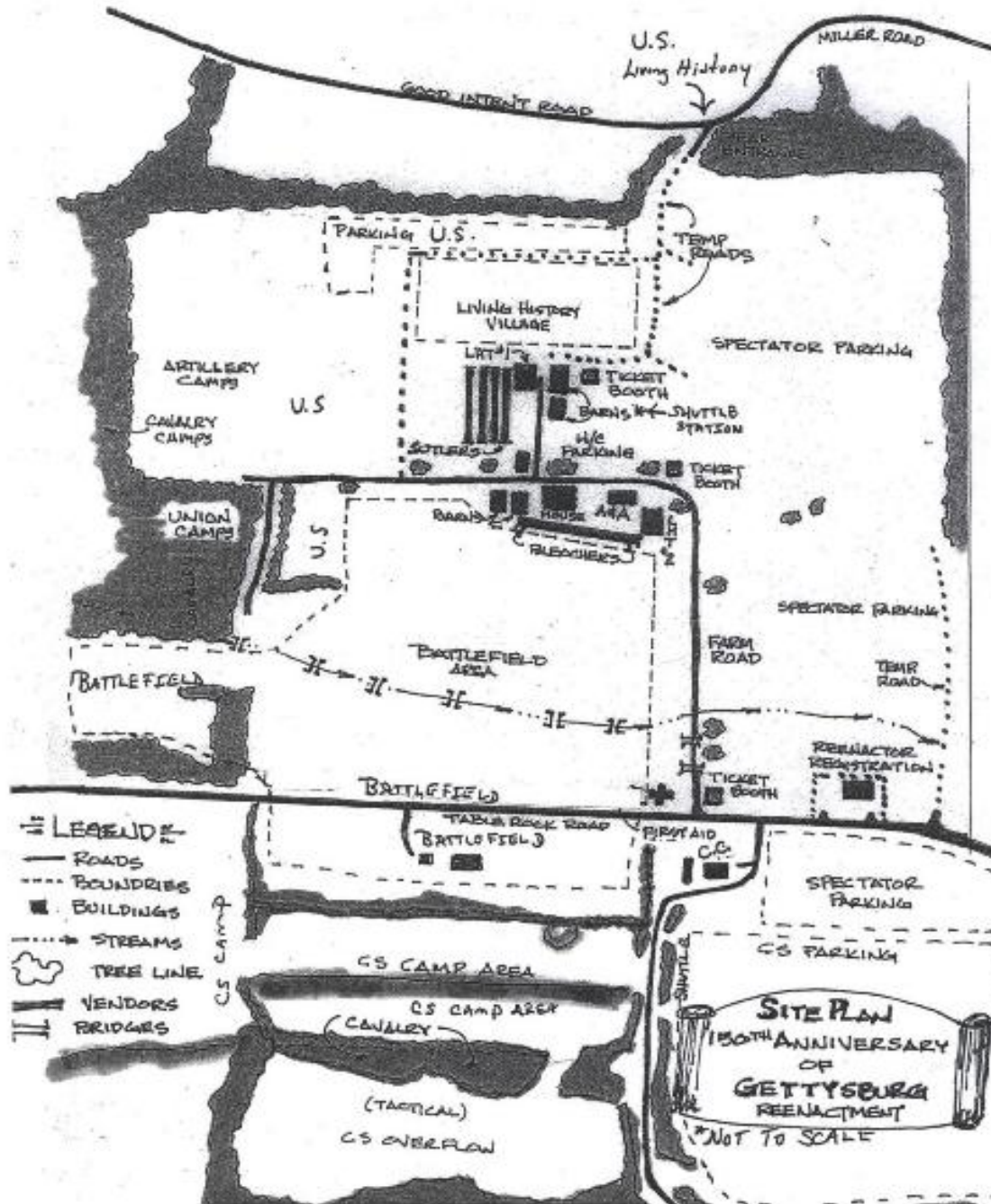
**Vehicles in Camps – Vehicles will need to be out of camp by 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 4, 2013**

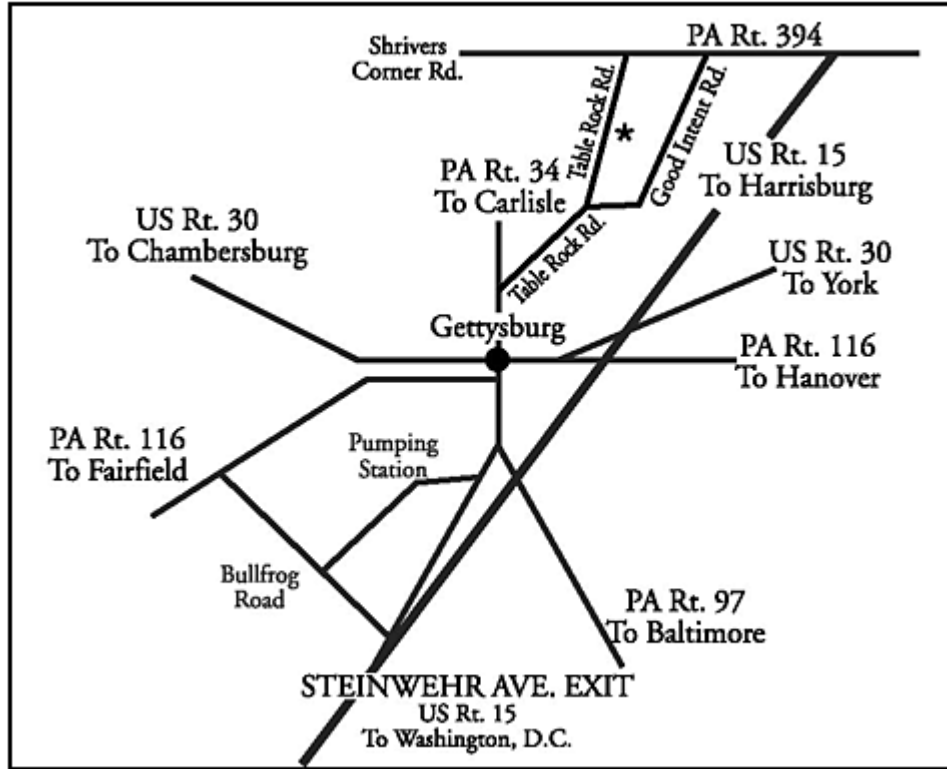
**No vehicles will be allowed in the camps after 11 a.m. Thursday until the conclusion of Sunday's battle unless emergency permission is obtained from the U.S. or C.S. command.**

Military provosts will assist in enforcing this regulation. Be advised that violating vehicles will be towed and impounded near the command center by event security and will then be released upon payment of \$100 towing fee to cover cost of removal. The vast majority of reenactors request and fully support this policy

## Driving Directions

### **FROM THE EAST:**

Route 30 West to US Route 15 North, to Hunterstown Exit, Route 394, (Shrivvers Corner Road). Left on Shrivvers Corner Road to left on Table Rock Road to parking lots

### **FROM THE NORTH:**

Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) to exit 236 (US Route 15 South). Follow US Route 15 South to Hunterstown Exit, Route 394, (Shrivvers Corner Road). Right on Shrivvers Corner Road to left on Table Rock Road to parking lots.

### **FROM THE SOUTH:**

Follow US Route 15 North to Hunterstown Exit, Route 394, (Shrivvers Corner Road). Left on Shrivvers Corner Road to left on Table Rock Road to parking lots.

### **FROM THE WEST:**

US Route 30 East to left on Herr's Ridge Road, left on Biglerville Road (Pa Rte 34), right on Goldenville Road, right on Table Rock Road to parking lots.

### **FROM GETTYSBURG:**

Route 34 North (Carlisle Street) to right on Table Rock Road to parking lots.
